Since its founding in 1998, more than 305 specially surfaced fields have been built or are under construction. Miracle Leagues serve more than 200,000 individuals with special needs. The Miracle League has been part of the Sarasota/Manatee community since 2012 and Cardinal Mooney has been a partner from nearly the beginning.



Our Cardinal Mooney student volunteers are paired up as buddies to the players. They assist with hitting, running the bases and fielding the ball. Our students also set-up, clean-up, work the concession stand and announce the games. 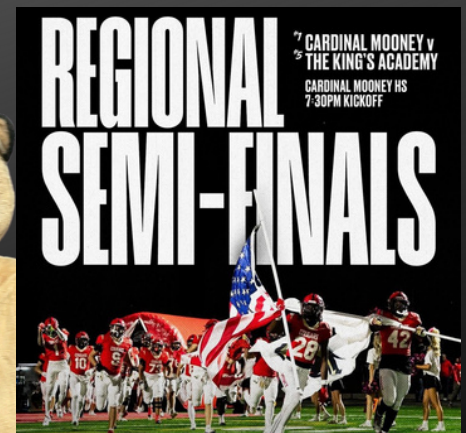

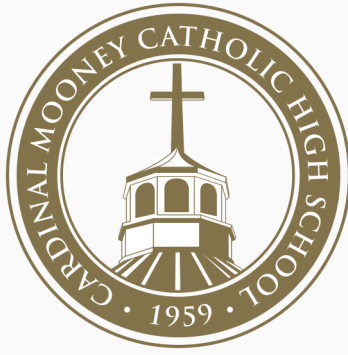
