

ACADEMIC SERVICES

GREAT BOOKS HONORS

Senior Level Course: The purpose of this course is to enable students, using texts of high complexity, to develop knowledge of great literature through advanced integrated educational experiences of reading, writing, and language. Emphasis will be on representative "great books," including ones with varied cultural influences, highlighting the major genres, themes, issues, and influences associated with Catholic theology and literature. Text may include titles such as: *Violence and the Sacred*, *The Man Who Was Thursday*, *The End of the Modern World*, *The Violent Bear it Away*, *The Moviegoer*, and *A Canticle for Leibowitz*

HOLOCAUST EDUCATION HONORS

One Semester Course: Open to Seniors, Juniors on a space available basis
This course consists of the following content area strands: American History, World History, Geography, Humanities, Civics, and Government. The primary content emphasis for this course pertains to the examination of the events of the Holocaust (1933-1945) and the systematic, methodically planned annihilation of European Jews. Students will explain the effect Nazi policies had on other groups targeted by the government of Nazi Germany. Students will analyze the circumstances from the end of the First World War, the Treaty of Versailles's effects, the Weimar Republic's duration, and Hitler's rise to and consolidation of power. Students will explore the pseudoscientific and eugenic roots of Nazi ideology, the development of anti-Jewish policies, and the Nazi propaganda campaign.

AP COMPUTER PRINCIPLES

AP Computer Science Principles is an introductory college-level computing course that introduces students to the breadth of the field of computer science. Students learn to design and evaluate solutions and apply computer science to solve problems through the development of algorithms and programs. They incorporate abstraction into programs and use data to discover new knowledge. Students also explain how computing innovations and computing systems—including the Internet—work, explore their potential impacts, and contribute to a collaborative and ethical computing culture.
