"A Medical School Primer for High School Students" June 9 – June 20, 2025

We are pleased to announce LECOM Bradenton's 2025 Medical Science Academy (MSA). This two-week summer experience will provide an opportunity for high school students to interact closely with faculty and medical students from the College of Medicine. In the first week, students will attend classes in large and small groups as well as participate in hands-on laboratory activities and an interactive suture skills session with volunteers from the US Army. Anatomy lab includes cat dissection. Demonstrations will be given by Manatee County Utilities as well as Manatee County Search and Rescue. Additionally, in the second week, students will receive Basic First Aid training, CPR training, Stop the Bleed training, tour Blake Hospital's trauma bays, operating rooms, step down units, emergency medical helicopter, and interact with the medical flight crew. The second week will also include LECOM Dental Day in which the students learn from LECOM faculty and participate in simulation lab as well as LECOM Pharmacy Day where students learn from LECOM faculty and participate in a compounding activity.

MSA Family Night Tuesday, May 6, 2025, 5:30 p.m.

MSA students and their parents will gather in Lecture Hall 211 in LECOM's College of Medicine (COM) Building which is located at 5000 Lakewood Ranch Blvd. The following activities will take place during this meeting:

- Welcome & Introduction of MSA Staff
- MSA Program Description
- Distribution of Anatomy & Physiology Textbooks (to be returned to LECOM on Friday, June 13th)
- Parental Signature on required documents for participation in MSA.
- Tour of LECOM's College of Osteopathic Medicine facility

Description of Activities

WEEK ONE: LECOM College of Osteopathic Medicine, 5000 Lakewood Ranch Blvd, Bradenton, FL 34211

- Formal lecture-based presentations provided by the College of Medicine faculty based on the central theme of Gastroenterology. The students will take a short quiz on what they learned.
- Problem-Based Learning (PBL) Cases on topics related to the Gastroenterology lecture theme.
 - This small group setting is the same way our LECOM medical and dental students learn their material. MSA students will be divided into PBL groups consisting of approximately 8 students with second year Osteopathic Medical School students (OMSII) as instructors. Students will discuss and learn about patient cases from a primary care perspective simulating real life patient and clinical scenarios. The PBL groups will have four days to understand the patient's condition and develop a diagnosis exploring the basic medical sciences (Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, etc.) associated with the case. They will have two hours on the last day of week one to prepare a grand rounds type presentation of the case, which will be delivered during the graduation program Friday, June 20th.
- The LECOM College of Osteopathic Medicine campus cafeteria will provide the students with a box lunch and snacks for week one. Students may bring their own lunch and snacks which are to be stored in a

designated MSA section in the cafeteria. According to LECOM policy, no food or drink is allowed in rooms outside of the cafeteria.

WEEK TWO:

- During the second week of the program, MSA students will be divided into 2 groups. Groups will be assigned a morning session or afternoon session during which time they will participate in a variety of health-related activities including Dental Day, Pharmacy Day, and Trauma Day at Blake Hospital. Students will also spend a FULL DAY participating in L.E.T.S. Safety Day where they will undergo Basic First Aid certification and CPR certification as well as hear from Manatee County Search and Rescue. LUNCH WILL BE ON YOUR OWN FOR WEEK TWO.
