On Monday March 3 and Tuesday March 4, six students from Cardinal Mooney attended the Model UN Conference at Florida Gulf Coast University. The judges for the conference include graduates of MIT, Harvard, Cornell, Tufts, etc. and vary from physicians to economists. The chairs for the committees are junior and senior Model UN students at UF, UCF, and FSU. Cardinal Mooney competed with 18 other schools in the region. We were the smallest contingent with 6 versus an average of 40 from Gulf Coast High School, Fort Meyers High Schools, etc. but we did extremely well for our first SWFLMUN conference.

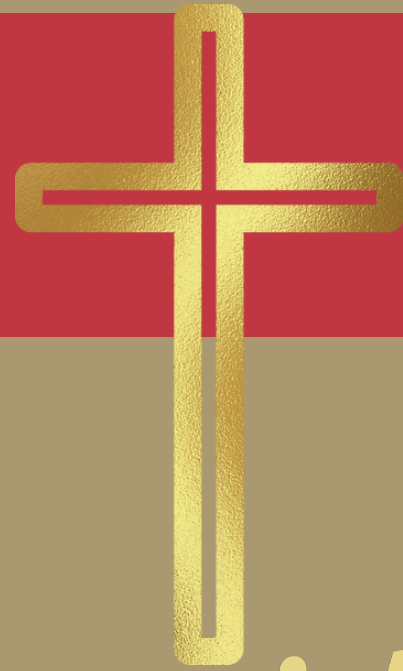
