Application Process

The process is simple and consists of the three items below.

Answer the two essay questions below and limit each response to 500-1000 words.

- b) Share something else about yourself; your goals and aspirations.
- c) Submit at least one recommendation letter from someone other than a relative or teacher.



Application Deadline and Details

The application must be submitted by Friday, March 28, 2025.

The winner will be announced at the end-of-the-year class award ceremonies on April 24, 2025.

All female students, grades 9-11, are eligible and encouraged to apply for this scholarship. Applicants will be judged on their essays, accomplishments in school activities, community involvement, recommendation letter(s) and an interview, if applicable.

A \$1,000 scholarship will be applied to the student's tuition for the 2025-2026 school year.
